Students are expected to act appropriately on the trip at all times.

Students should not be disruptive.

Girls should not be in boy's room and boys should not be in girl's rooms for any reason.

Follow all safety rules on the airplane, bus and at the hotel.

Show respect and courtesy to your chaperone and others as a representative of the orchestra.

Follow directions given by the orchestra director, chaperones, or other adults (bus driver, tour guides, etc.) on the trip.

Adhere to the rules and boundaries that your parents set for you regarding cell phone usage. Please know that your parents are responsible for all charges for your phone usage at international rates which are extremely expensive. Cell phone usage includes any apps, texting, calling, etc.

Do not order movies, room service, etc. from your hotel room.

Bring a light raincoat or umbrella.

Contact your chaperone with concerns or questions.

Keep with you at all times the name and cell phone number of your chaperone. This will be provided for you prior to the trip.

Never walk around alone. Students must stay with their chaperone at all times!

Once your chaperone has walked you to your hotel room at night, you are to stay there until your chaperone greets you in the morning.

Keep track of your own personal belongings.

Be respectful of others who are visiting the same sites and locations.

Leave the plane, bus, and hotel areas visited just like you found them or better.

Be prepared to adapt to unexpected situations (rain, time delays, etc.)

Have phone numbers for the person to contact who will be picking you up upon return to the airport in Los Angeles.

In case of emergency, contact your chaperone first! The chaperone will then contact your parents.

Guard and care for your instrument at all times.
